



## HOLSTEIN AUSTRALIA ONLINE SHOWCASE SALE 2020

### VENDOR ENTRY FORM

The Holstein Australia Online Showcase Sale will take place as the feature event of Holstein Australia's virtual 2020 AGM on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October, broadcast live from Dairy House at AgriBio. Buyers and sellers can bid or view auctions from the comfort of their home or office in real-time using a computer, tablet or smartphone.

The online sale format reduces the traditional costs of sale for vendors and removes the need to prepare and transport animals to a sale yard. In the current climate with interstate travel restricted it also enables Holstein Australia members, wherever they are based, to participate.

Dairy Livestock Services, sole agents for the Holstein Australia Online Showcase Sale, will arrange with vendors for all animals to be filmed prior to the sale to ensure the highest quality presentation of animals. **Entries close Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020** and vendor forms must be submitted by that date to Holstein Australia.

## 2020 HOLSTEIN AUSTRALIA ONLINE SHOWCASE SALE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**1. Registration Requirements** - All animals entered for the sale must be registered with Holstein Australia by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020 being the closing date for entries.

### 2. Entry Forms

2.1 A signed entry form must be completed for each entry and lodged by the due date.

2.2 A National Cattle Health Declaration form must be completed by each entrant. Only one National Cattle Health Declaration form is required to be completed irrespective of the number of entries by a single vendor.

2.3 Failure to complete one (1) entry form per entry and one (1) National Cattle Health Declaration form per vendor will result in entries being rejected.

**3. Closing Date** - Entries close 5pm Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and completed entry forms must be received by that date and time at Holstein Australia, AgriBio, 5 Ring Road, Bundoora, Vic, 3083. The Sale Committee reserves the right to reject entries not complying in every respect with these conditions.

**4. Reserve price** – Reserve price on all lots is to be confirmed.

### 5. Entry Criteria

5.1 All animals entered for the sale are subject to inspection prior to cataloguing. This inspection is for the purpose of ensuring that the animal is structurally sound and displays satisfactory breed characteristics befitting a Holstein Australia Approved Sale.

5.2 All animals must be descended from a Dam and Grandam born in Australia.

5.3 No age conditions apply, although vendors should note that calves under 90 days may have transport restrictions

5.4 Production and depth of classification information is a requirement of entry to the 2020 Holstein Australia Online Showcase Sale.

5.5 The provision of genomic breeding values is optional, though preferred.

5.6 All animals must be presented for video purposes in a manner befitting a Holstein Australia Approved Sale, including acting in accordance with the All Dairy Breeds National Show Ring Code of Ethics.

5.7 All animals must be halter-broken prior to transportation to the buyer following the sale.

**6. Breeding History** - The vendor must advise the Sale Committee in writing one (1) week prior to the online auction on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 of any change in the entry's breeding history since submission of the entry form. The sale committee is authorised to publish details of any such change by way of supplementary sheet or public announcement or in such other manner as it may determine.

### 7. Sale Format

7.1 The 2020 Holstein Australia Online Showcase Sale will be broadcast live via the Internet, with full video, imagery and sound. Animals will be videoed prior to sale and do not need to be transported to the sale venue.

7.2 Holstein Australia and Dairy Livestock Services will market and promote the 2020 Online Showcase Sale online and via social media. Information to promote the sale will also be provided to national dairy media.

7.3 Video footage and photography requirements for animals entered in the sale will be confirmed with vendors, with the cost of video footage and photography to be met by the vendor.
